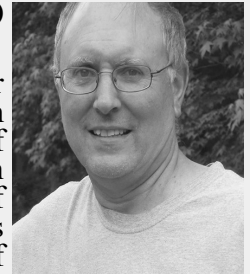
FEATURED SPEAKERS

Gail received her B.S. in Entomology & M.S. in Wood Science & Technology from the University of California-Berkeley. She has over 20 years of experience in scientific research on urban insect biology, ecology, chemical ecology and behavior. She has published over 21 scientific papers. Her projects have involved major manufacturing companies. She has been an expert witness in bed bug, termite, beetle, and construction defect lawsuits. Gail formed the Getty Entomological Research and Consulting Company.

PAUL BELLO



A licensed pest management applicator since 1976, Paul holds a B.S. in Entomology from the University of Georgia and M.B.A. in Accounting from Adelphi University. Paul was a student of Austin M Frishman, one of the industry's foremost experts, at State University of New York, Farmingdale campus.

Paul published the "Bed Bug Combat Manual", a valuable resource in the battle against bed bugs. He was editorial author for the Mallis Handbook of Pest Control (8th Edition) regarded as the industry's premier reference. He has written many articles on a variety of pest management subjects that have appeared in numerous trade publications. His monthly column, "On the Road With...Paul Bello" has appeared in state trade associations magazines since 1995.

Paul appears on television and has been in the Sunday New York Times, Newsday, Atlanta Journal Constitution and other print media. He has presented at industry conferences and seminars. His expertise includes general pest management, commercial pest management, & termite management. He advises on difficult pest situations at a variety of facilities including zoos, theme parks, hospitals, food production facilities, apartments, condominiums, distribution centers, schools, universities, assisted living facilities and others.
